What is "Trunk or Treat"

Throughout the United States increased popularity for a "Trunk-or-Treat" instead of the traditional door-to-door trick or treating. In this setting trick-or-treating is done from parked car to parked car in a local parking lot, often at a school or church. The activity involves the open trunk of a car, or back of an SUV or van displaying candy, and often games and decorations. Some parents regard trunk-or-treating as a safer alternative to trick-or-treating; while other parents see it as an easier alternative to walking the neighborhood with their children. These have become increasingly popular in recent years. Households wishing to participate can even just set up a table or booth for the children to visit.

Everything is totally left to each person participating. Décor is not required nor is being in costume. The purpose is to create a fun and safe environment for children to enjoy the custom.
