

IF YOU'RE GOING TO BE OUT OF TOWN ON VACATION, PLEASE LET US KNOW AND WE WILL GET YOUR CART/S FROM YOUR HOUSE OR GARAGE AND EMPTY AND RETURN THEM FOR YOU.

AS PART OF OUR CONTRACT WITH THE TOWN WE WILL BE PROVIDING AN ON-CALL BULK SERVICE PICKUP IF YOU HAVE AN ITEM TOO LARGE FOR THE CARTS, FURNITURE ITEMS, MULTIPLE EXTRA BAGS OF TRASH, APPLIANCES, STOVES, REFRIGERATORS, WASHER, DRYER, MICROWAVE, DISHWASHER, HOT WATER HEATER, AIR CONDITIONERS, LARGE METAL ITEMS, BATTERIES, ELECTRONICS.
YOU CAN JUST CALL IN, TEXT, OR EMAIL AND WE WILL GIVE YOU THE PICKUP DAY.

IF YOU HAVE TRASH CANS YOU WANT TO THROW AWAY SINCE SWITCHING TO THE NEW CARTS, WE WILL INCLUDE SOME LABELS IN THE PACKETS TO ATTACH TO THEM SO WE KNOW YOU WANT TO GET RID OF THEM.
